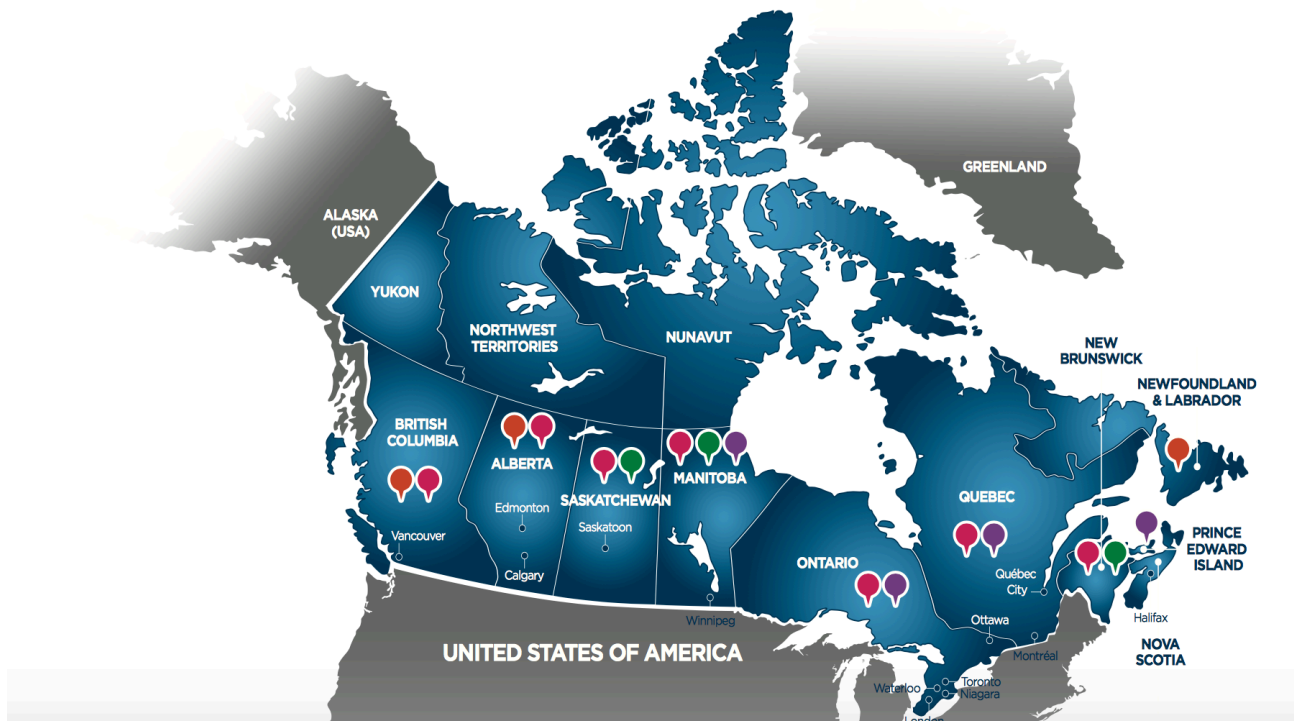


Manufacturing - Locations that might interest you:

Edmonton (Alberta)

- Besides being Canada's largest hydrocarbon processing region, Edmonton also has a competitive petrochemical and biochemical industry.
- Edmonton companies dominate in machinery manufacturing, which primarily service the energy/mining, agriculture, and construction sectors.
- Home to most engineers in Canada (per population).
- Trucking and warehousing hub for Western Canada.

ONTARIO

Waterloo Region (Ontario)

- Waterloo Region is Ontario's manufacturing and automotive corridor. Clusters in Waterloo's advanced manufacturing sector include automation, robotics, Industry 4.0, aerospace, plastics and fabricated metals.
- A thriving automation corridor runs from Windsor/Detroit to Toronto of which Waterloo Region is a key member as the region has one of the densest clusters of manufacturing automation businesses in North America.
- Waterloo's collision of technology, software and manufacturing has positioned the region as a hub for Industry 4.0 technologies and processes.
- Key companies include Rockwell Automation, Rimowa (Louis Vuitton), Christie Digital, and Frito Lay.

City of Hamilton (Ontario)

- Industrial manufacturing has been the driving force of Hamilton's local economy for more than a century.
- Key focus: advanced manufacturing including automotive, machinery and robotics.

London (Ontario)

- London is home to a very strong manufacturing sector in automotive (Toyota, GM, Ford, Honda), Aerospace, Defence, Green Technology and Building products.

QUEBEC

Montreal (Quebec)

- Focus: advanced manufacturing
- Successful companies located in Greater Montreal include Axiom (Robotics), Advanced Motion & Control Ltd (Automation), electro-MAG (Machine security), Ferro Technique Ltd. (Automation) and many more.

Quebec City (Quebec)

- The many optics/photonics companies specialize in instrumentation (measuring, testing and analytic devices and systems), imaging, vision systems, optical communications and high-tech performance fibre optics.
- Key companies include Olympus NDT, ABB Inc. and many more.
